Readings:

Day 228 | Monday | November 16 | 2 Peter 1 | attributed to Simon Peter – to those who have received faith – may grace and peace be given to you abundantly; faith, goodness, knowledge, self control, endurance with godliness for these things are yours; Christ will come soon – remember what I have taught you; we have been eyewitnesses to the Majesty of Christ; prophecy comes from God.

Day 229 | Tuesday | November 17 | 2 Peter 2 | When is Jesus coming back?; Watch for false teachers; they will be judged. They have left the straight road gone astray...

Day 230 | Wednesday | November 18 | 2 Peter 3 | Remember the words of Jesus and the prophets spoken by the apostles; When is Jesus coming?; one day is like a thousand years for the Lord, God is not slow in the Lord's promise; be holy in the mean while; grow in grace and knowledge.

Day 231 | Thursday | November 19 | 1 John 1 | 1 We declare to you what was from the beginning, what we have heard, what we have seen with our eyes, what we have looked at and touched with our hands, concerning the word of life— ² this life was revealed, and we have seen it and testify to it, and declare to you the eternal life that was with the Father and was revealed to us—³ we declare to you what we have seen and heard so that you also may have fellowship with us; and truly our fellowship is with the Father and with his Son Jesus Christ. ⁴ We are writing these things so that our^[a] joy may be complete. **God Is Light** ⁵ This is the message we have heard from him and proclaim to you, that God is light and in him there is no darkness at all.

Day 232 | Friday | November 20 | 1 John 2 | Christ is our advocate; I am writing that you love one another; walk in the light; Love God; the end is near; victory over false teachings; abide in him.

Pray for the redemption of the World. Pray for those persecuted for the faith today. Pray for your personal discipleship and your calling to serve the Kingdom of God in your world.
