मैं इक को गांव की नदी दिखाने ले जाती हूं। "देखो! एक गांववाला मछली पकड़ रहा है!"




मैं इक को अपने परिवार का बड़ा धान का खेत दिखाती हूं। खेत पीले धान से लदा है!




"और यह वो जगह है जहाँ हम चावल को रखते हैं।" "चावल हमेशा सूखा ही रहना चाहिए!"










"यह हमारा आम का बगीचा है।" "इस समय आम पके और रसीले हैं।" इक, ज़रा सावधानी से!




"तुम चिंता मत करो, इक! हम यहां पर आराम कर सकते हैं।" "यह हमारा ही घर है।"
