Day 188 | Monday | September 21 | <u>2 Thessalonians 1</u> | We give thanks to you; we pray for you so that you might be glorified in Jesus Christ.

Day 189 | Tuesday | September 22 | <u>2 Thessalonians 2</u> | Jesus is coming ... do not be afraid; Sanctification – to be made holy and right with God; God called you through the proclamation of the good news so that you can obtain glory; comfort your hearts and strengthen them in every good work and word.

Day 190 | Wednesday | September 23 | <u>2 Thessalonians 3</u> | Pray for us that the Gospel will spread rapidly; keep the faith; work quietly toward the goal of the Gospel; may the peace of the Lord be with you at all times.

Day 191 | Thursday | September 24 | <u>1 Timothy 1</u> | Teach love above all things; The grace of our Lord was poured out on me abundantly, along with the faith and love that are in Christ Jesus (vs 14); Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners—of whom I am the worst; keep the faith.

Day 192 | Friday | September 25 | <u>1 Timothy 2</u> | Pray with supplications, prayers, intercessions, and thanksgiving be made for everyone; misunderstood code of conduct for women more Hellenistic than Hebrew.
